Key Vocabulary

Landmark: A feature of a landscape or place that is easily recognised. It could be something made by people (a human feature) or something that occurred naturally (a physical feature). Big Ben is a **landmark** in London.

Milton Keynes: the city we live in which is in England.

Local: in the area where we live

London: the capital city of England

UK: the United Kingdom and its four countries – England, Scotland Wales and Northern Ireland.
