



Llandudno is a seaside resort, town and community in Conwy County Borough, Wales, located on the Creuddyn peninsula, which protrudes into the Irish Sea.





Compare	Comparing involves identifying similarities and/or differences between two or more things.
Contrast	Contrasting involves comparing two or more things in order to show their differences.
Coordinate	A point on a grid has two numbers to identify its position. These numbers are known as coordinates.
Economic activity	The amount a country sells and makes is called economic activity.
Four- figure grid reference	A four-figure grid references can be used to pinpoint a location to within a square.
Grid reference	A grid reference tells you where something is on a map.
Human feature	Things that are made or built by humans.
Land use	Land use is when an area is used for a specific purpose.
Physical feature	Anything that is on Earth naturally.
Settlement	Settlements are places where people live and sometimes work.
Trade	Trade is the buying and selling of goods and services.
