

# stem leaves flowers Trees

### Key Vocabulary A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It wild plants doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows. garden plants Garden plants are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens. Weeds are wild plants that grow in places weed where people don't want them. deciduous A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year. An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all evergreen year round, even in the winter. Roots take in water and nutrients from the roots soil and keep the plant in the ground. The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers. Leaves catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food. Flowers attract insects and birds.
