Attendance Matters!

At Giles Brook we place great importance on good attendance and punctuality. We know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly late or absent from school do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class. Please support the school in this by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and arrives ready to learn and on time at 8.40am.

Poor punctuality can lead to your child...

• Feeling embarrassed in front of their friends

• Missing the beginning of vital lessons making them fall behind

- Missing important instructions for
- the rest of the school day

• Learning bad habits which could affect their employability in the future

The table below shows just how much education could be missed by being late to school each day:

Minutes late per day	Learning time lost in a year
5 minutes	3 ½ days
10 minutes	7 days
15 minutes	10 ½ days
20 minutes	14 days
30 minutes	21 days
