# BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

At Giles Brook School we welcome all children at both our breakfast and after school care clubs. Children can attend for as many sessions as they would like, from a one off session, to every day. Booking is easy and can be made via School Gateway up to the day before the session required (for later booking please contact the school office)

Our **Breakfast Club** runs daily from 7.45am. Children are offered varied options for a nutritious breakfast and have access to games as well as the opportunity to be involved in sporting activities.

Sunset Club runs two sessions from the end of the school day until 4.30pm (early session) and 6.00pm (late session - includes a light tea)). We have lots of activities for the children such as outdoor play, crafts, games and ICT.

**Sports Clubs** run every day of the school year for years 1 to 6 and vary daily. These are booked on a half termly basis and the next booking session will be for the next half term starting on 31st October 2023.
