Milton Keynes is in **Buckinghamshire**.


The longest river in the United Kingdom is the **River Severn.**



Boundary	A line which separates different regions.	
Capital City	The city that holds the seat of government for that country.	
Compass points	A compass point is one of the 32 marks on the dial of a compass that show direction, for example north, south, east, and west.	
Great Britain	The geographical area made up of England, Wales and Scotland.	
Hill	Naturally raised piece of land, not as high as a mountain.	
Human feature	Things that are made or built by humans.	
Mountain	Area of land, steeper and higher than a hill (over 600 metres high)	
Mountain range	A collection or group of mountains or hills.	
OS map	The Ordnance Survey (OS) is the mapping agency for Great Britain	
Physical feature	Anything that is on Earth naturally.	
United Kingdom	The geographical area made up of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
