

The Locations of Rainforests Around the World



| Key Vocabulary | |
|----------------|---|
| Latitude | The distance of a place north or south of the earth's equator |
| Longitude | the distance of a place east or west of the Greenwich meridian |
| Hemisphere | a half of the earth |
| Equator | The equator is a circle of latitude that divides Earth into the northern and southern hemispheres |
| Coast | The part of the land adjoining or near the sea |
| River | a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river. |
