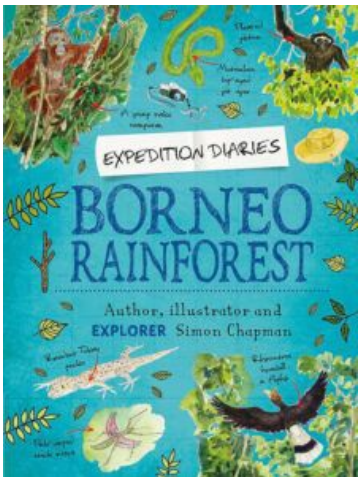

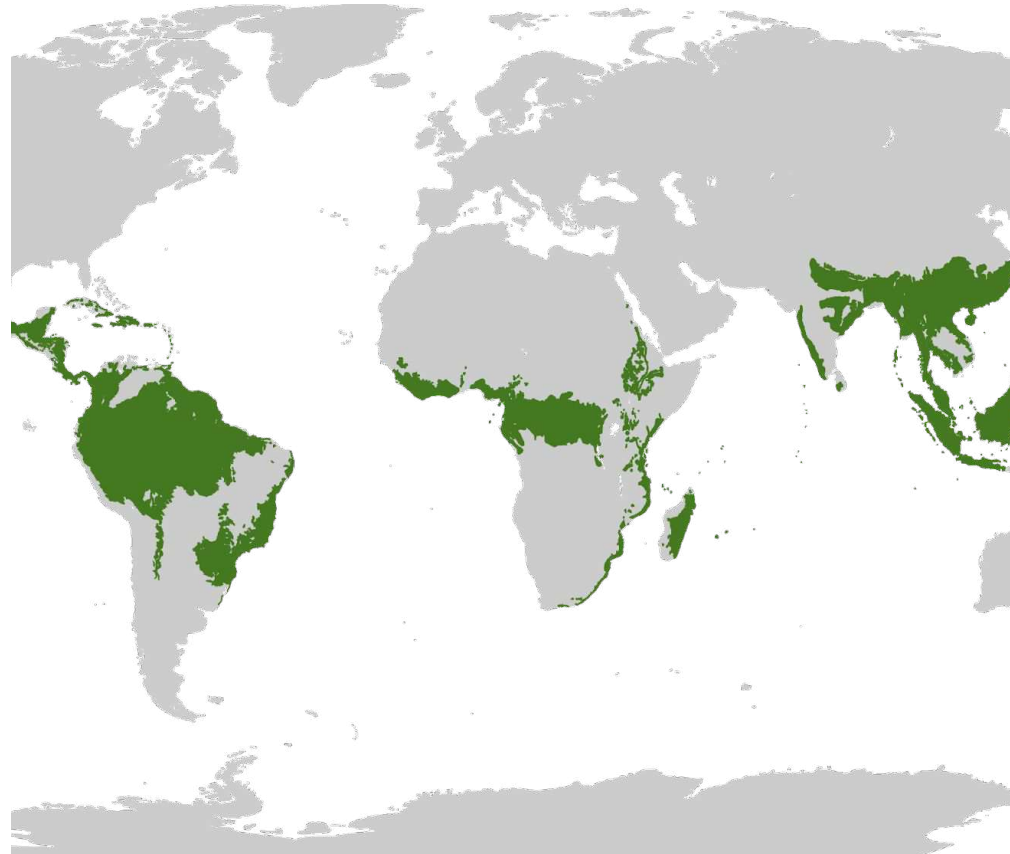

The Locations of Rainforests Around the World



Key Vocabulary

Latitude	The distance of a place north or south of the earth's equator
Longitude	the distance of a place east or west of the Greenwich meridian
Hemisphere	a half of the earth
Equator	The equator is a circle of latitude that divides Earth into the northern and southern hemispheres
Coast	The part of the land adjoining or near the sea
River	a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river.
