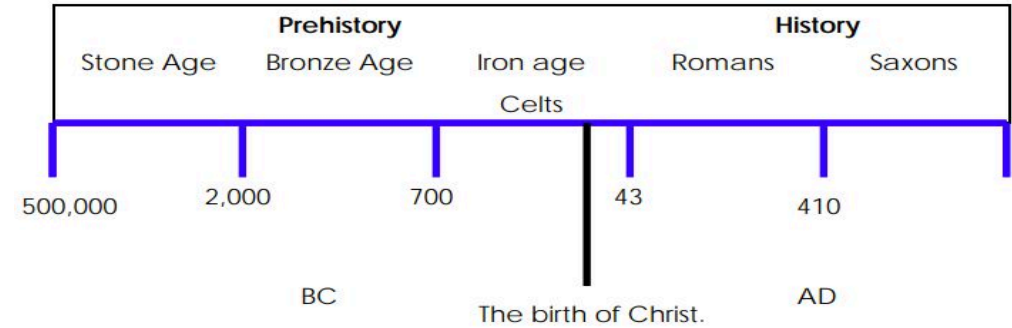

AD	AD is used to show the dates after the birth of Jesus
Amphitheatre	An open-air venue used for entertainment, performances, and sports
BC	Before Christ
Celts	A modern term for people living in Europe during the Iron Age
Century	A period of 100 years
Civilisation	A group of people with their own languages and way of life
Conquer	To take control of people/country by military force
Democracy	A government run by the people. Each citizen has a say (or vote) in how the government is run.
Emperor	Is a man who rules an empire or is the head of state in an empire
Empire	A group of countries ruled by one leader called an Emperor
Invade	To enter a country by force with large numbers of soldiers in order to take possession of it
